Introduction:

Discussion:

Read: Genesis 16:7–13

2. How does God's interaction with Hagar demonstrate both compassion and truth?
3. What can we learn from Hagar's response to God's presence?

Read: Luke 12:6–7 and Hebrews 4:15–16

4. What examples does Jesus use to illustrate God's care?
5. How should knowing God's detailed care affect the way we view ourselves and others?
6. From the Hebrews passage, why is it significant that Jesus understands our weaknesses?
7. What does it mean to approach God's throne "with confidence"?
8. What keeps people from bringing their struggles honestly before God?

Reflection:

9. Who in your life may need to experience God's love through your attention, encouragement, or care this week?
10. Where do you need to trust that God truly sees you today?
