



Bible Study: Jehovah Jireh – The Lord Will Provide

Introduction:

1. Can you remember a time when God provided something you needed? What did you learn from that experience?

Discussion:

Read: Genesis 22:1–14

2. Why do you think God waited until Abraham demonstrated his obedience before providing the ram?
3. What might Abraham have learned about God through this experience that he could not have learned simply by hearing about God's provision?
4. Are there areas of your life where God may be asking you to trust Him before you see the provision?

Read: Philippians 4:19 and Matthew 6:25–33

5. What does Paul mean when he says, “And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus”?
6. How does knowing that God's resources are unlimited change the way we approach our needs?
7. Why do you think Jesus connects worry with a lack of trust in God's provision?
8. What does Jesus mean by “Seek the kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously” (v. 33)? 6:25?

Reflection:

9. What is one worry you need to surrender to God and trust Him with?
10. If you truly believed that “Jehovah Jireh” is your provider, what would change about the way you live this week?

Prayer:

Spend some time thanking God for His ultimate provision in Jesus and His daily provisions for each of us. Present your worries to Him and trust that even when you can't see the provision He remains the Provider.
